

- Select a tail gunner to bring up the rear on the trail
- Prepare a description of the run including:

distance from meeting point, nature of run (exploration, camping, fishing, 4WD vehicle and driving challenge, scenic tour, etc.)

• Prepare info to be published in SLO 4-Wheelers newsletter:

Date of departure and return, Meeting place & time for departure,

Any special vehicle equipment requirements for the run,

Proposed schedule of activities with times and places itemized, Location of nearest gas, Location of nearest medical facility, etc.

- Insure that all SLO 4-Wheeler members are reminded and establish a head count of those who plan to go
- Conduct a drivers meeting immediately before the run, including all drivers:

Discuss safety issues,

Discuss proposed route and schedule,

Perform vehicle safety inspection.

• Prepare a written report for the next general meeting and newsletter including:

Names of all who attended,

Description of events and activities, safety check results and fines, FUBAR flag nominees
